Even though we have not had any Elder Newsletters since May, a lot has been happening and I want to give you a brief update on a couple of items:

**PASTOR SEARCH PROCESS:** The Lead Pastor position was posted on June 20, 2024 on the Northwest Alliance (our district) site and the National Christian & Missionary Alliance site. We are in the process of posting this on other external sites as well. Please continue to pray for Pastor Next and the Pastor Search Committee who have been meeting monthly (and soon to be more often) and have developed a process of evaluation of the applications!

**MINISTRY APPLICATION EVENT/LOCAL NEIGHBORHOOD ALLIANCE:** The next Ministry Application Plan event is what we want to primarily use this newsletter for. We are planning a local community event for September 8, 2024 at 12 noon which will happen after our Annual Meeting. It will be called **The Good Neighbor Alliance Event.** This event will allow us to once again love and serve our community but this time it will involve the local community around our church.

As you may recall in Elder Newsletter 4.1, we introduced the Willamette Valley Big Band Concert Event and in Elder Newsletter 5.1 we shared what happened at that very successful event! It was exciting to see so many of you involved with this event and we celebrated the stories from so many of you of how we were able to intersect with our community and love and serve our community.

In this September 2024 event, we are inviting our neighbors in the vicinity of N 4th to N 10th and N Ivy to N Locust for a get together at our church in which we will have people be a part of an emergency preparedness information event. The invitation will occur through personal interaction by those of us who live in the area around the church. We plan to canvass the above area with personal invitations. It is our hope to have this be a bilingual event and we are hoping to get SDA brothers and sisters to be a part of this event as well.

We want to let our neighbors know that we are one of their neighbors and we want to be available in the event of an emergency scenario. We will let neighbors know what Canby Alliance Church can do in the event of such an emergency. We want to practically love our neighbors through this event. We want to see growth in the connections between neighbors. We would like to have presentations by organizations like the CERT team, Red Cross and Rotary. We discussed using our church as a location where community neighbors can recharge cell phones and be a central location for people to get important information during such an emergency.

We plan to serve free hamburgers and hot dogs and have a chance to meet neighbors. We want to have a children's activity area and we are hoping to get our youth involved in this. We want to have a community board where people can share what is great about our local community and what needs there are in the community to improve the community and foster more connection with one another.
